is an independent researcher, academic and consultant with 35 years of experience teaching in the university sector and over 20 years of experience consulting to institutions in the public, civil society, private and international development/donor sectors. His work and research portfolio covers public health, substance use, burn and traffic injuries, social justice, anti-discrimination, reconciliation, and development policy and practice.
